## Wyoming Landscape Architect Elected as Regional Director of International Organization

RESTON, VIRGINIA (UNITED STATES) – October 9, 2014 – Wyoming landscape architect Allison Fleury has been elected to a two-year term as Region 4 Director for the Council of Landscape Architectural Registration Boards (CLARB).

As the Region 4 Director, Fleury will represent CLARB members from Alberta, Colorado, Kansas, Nebraska, New Mexico, Oklahoma, South Dakota and Wyoming on the Board of Directors of CLARB. Fleury also currently serves on the Landscape Architecture Continuing Education Systems Administration Committee (2013–2015).

Previously, Fleury served as Region 3 Alternate Director (2012–2014), as well as on the Grading Committee in July 2010 and January 2011, and the Redline Committee in 2012.

Closer to home, Fleury has served on the Wyoming Board of Architects and Landscape Architects since 2009. She is currently serving in her second year as President.

Fleury earned a Bachelor of Applied Arts, Human Geography from Ryerson Polytechnical Institute in 1987 and her Masters of Landscape Architecture from the University of Guelph in 1994. She is currently a licensed landscape architect in Wyoming (and Idaho) at Inside Out Landscape Architecture LLC and is also a CLARB Certified landscape architect.
